

Anti-EpCAM/TROP1/CD326 Antibody (Tucotuzumab)

Introduction

Tucotuzumab (Anti-EPCAM Recombinant Antibody) is an antigen-specific IgG1 monoclonal antibody targeting human epithelial cell adhesion molecule (EpCAM). Tucotuzumab can link two IL-2 molecules and is an immunosuppressant and anti-tumor active molecule.
