

# Anti-alpha Tubulin Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

## Introduction



TUBA1A Tubulin is the major constituent of microtubules. It binds two moles of GTP, one at an exchangeable site on the beta chain and one at a non-exchangeable site on the alpha-chain.
