

Anti-Androgen Receptor Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Androgen receptor (AR), a zinc finger transcription factor belonging to the nuclear receptor superfamily, is activated by phosphorylation and dimerization upon ligand binding. This promotes nuclear localization and binding of AR to androgen response elements in androgen target genes.
