

Anti-Axin 2 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Axin1 (Axis inhibition protein 1) and Axin2 are multidomain scaffold proteins that negatively regulate Wnt signaling. Axin1 interacts with APC, GSK-3 β , Dvl, and β -catenin and promotes the GSK-3 β -mediated phosphorylation and subsequent degradation of β -catenin. Down-regulates beta-catenin.
