

Anti-Complex III Subunit 7 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

This is a component of the ubiquinol-cytochrome c reductase complex (complex III or cytochrome b-c1 complex), which is part of the mitochondrial respiratory chain. This component is involved in redox-linked proton pumping. Caution Was originally thought to be the ubiquinone-binding protein (QP-C).
