

Anti-Cystathionase Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Catalyzes the last step in the transsulfuration pathway from methionine to cysteine. Has broad substrate specificity. Converts cystathionine to cysteine, ammonia and 2-oxobutanoate.
