

Anti-FKBP38 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Constitutively inactive PPIase, which becomes active when bound to calmodulin and calcium. Seems to act as a chaperone for BCL2, targets it to the mitochondria and modulates its phosphorylation state.
