

Anti-GSTA3 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Conjugation of reduced glutathione to a wide number of exogenous and endogenous hydrophobic electrophiles. Catalyzes isomerization reactions that contribute to the biosynthesis of steroid hormones. Efficiently catalyze obligatory double-bond isomerizations of delta5-androstene-3,17-dione and delta5-pregnene-3,20-dione, precursors to Tosterone and progesterone, respectively.
