

Anti-Heparanase 1 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Endoglycosidase which is a cell surface and extracellular matrix-degrading enzyme. Cleaves heparan sulfate proteoglycans (HSPGs) into heparan sulfate side chains and core proteoglycans.
