

Anti-HNF 4 alpha Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

HNF-4-alpha is a transcription factor that belongs to the steroid hormone receptor superfamily. Binds to DNA sites required for the transcription of alpha 1-antitrypsin, apolipoprotein CIII, transthyretin genes and HNF1-alpha.
