

Anti-Hsc70 Interacting Protein HIP Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

One HIP oligomer binds the ATPase domains of at least two HSC70 molecules dependent on activation of the HSC70 ATPase by HSP40. Stabilizes the ADP state of HSC70 that has a high affinity for substrate protein.
