

## Anti-MMP14 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

### Introduction

MMP14 Seems to specifically activate progelatinase A. May thus trigger invasion by tumor cells by activating progelatinase A on the tumor cell surface. Belongs to the peptidase M10A family.
