

Anti-Natriuretic Peptides B (5G5) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Brain natriuretic peptide (BNP) circulates in blood as a peptide hormone with natriuretic, vasodilatory and renin inhibitory properties. BNP is secreted predominantly by the left ventricular myocytes in response to volume expansion and pressure overload.
