

Anti-Pirh2 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

Mediates E3-dependent ubiquitination and proteasomal degradation of target proteins, including p53/TP53, HDAC1 and CDKN1B. Preferentially acts on tetrameric p53/TP53.
