

Anti-SUN2 Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

SUN proteins form part of the LINC complex - a protein bridge that spans the nuclear envelope linking the nucleoskeleton to the actin cytoskeleton. They are located on the inner nuclear membrane side of the complex.
