

Anti-Synaptophysin Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody

Introduction

SYP Possibly involved in structural functions as organizing other membrane components or in targeting the vesicles to the plasma membrane. Involved in the regulation of short-term and long-term synaptic plasticity. Belongs to the synaptophysin/synaptobrevin family. Homoheptamer or homotetramer. Note: This description may include information from UniProtKB.
